ROBERT MULLINS NAMED 2009 VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR



Robert Mullins has spent a lifetime serving the community in youth athletics, civic and local church service as well as holding community service positions within the Town of Smyrna and surrounding areas. From 1951-1954, he was a student at Smyrna High School, where he co-captained the football and basketball teams. He was also a member of the Smyrna High Boosters Club from 1960-1980. As a member of the Smyrna Little League, Robert served as an umpire from 1959-1966 and coach from 1967-1969. From 1970-1975, he was a board member of the Smyrna Babe Ruth League, followed by his part as one of the organizers and founders of the Smyrna Girl's Softball League from 1970-1973. He also coached during that same period and remained a coach in the Smyrna Youth Football League from 1972-1973. He served with Smyrna Christian School from 1969-1985 and Middle Tennessee Christian School from 1985 to present. He has also been a volunteer supporter of Smyrna West Alternative School. Robert served on the Smyrna Planning Commission from 1983-2001 and as Smyrna Commissioner of Utilities and Planning from 1993-1997. He served as the Smyrna Town Mayor from 1997-2001 and has served on the Regional Transportation Authority, Metropolitan Planning Authority, Greater Nashville Regional Council and Tennessee Municipal League. Robert has given his time as a board member of the United Way from 1997-2003; Campaign Chair in 2001; President in 2002 and Past President in 2003. He has been a member of Smyrna Rotary Club since 1998 and served as a board member, Secretary, President and Past President. Robert also volunteers in delivering Meals on Wheels. He has been a member of the Smyrna Church of Christ since 1951 and has served as a deacon from 1962-1980 and elder from 1980 to present. Robert makes numerous hospital visits to those in need and has also served on missions to the Honduras, Siberia and Greece. He is most deserving of this prestigious award as evidenced by his extreme commitment to the people of this community and others alike.

North Rutherford Soccer League – Ages U5 – U18. Registration, \$75. Register online at www.nrssoccer.org, or print off form and mail to address at top of form. In-person registration will be 2-20 and 2-27 from 10AM to 2PM at Rotary Soccer Park. To avoid late fees, mail-in registration must be postmarked no later than 2-27-10. . On-line registration will close at 12:01 AM 3/12/10. Practice starts the week of 3/29. Games begin on 4/10 and run through 5/29. Contact Bill Jordan at 459-2564.

Smyrna Baseball League – Ages 5 – 8. Start Smart age 4. Online registration at www.smyrnabaseball.org is ongoing through 2/20/10. In person registration at Stewartsboro Elementary School, on 2-6 and 2-13 from 9AM to 2PM. Fee is \$70, \$50 for Start Smart. Birth certificates are required if you didn't play previous season. Players are placed in programs based on their age as of April 30, 2010. 4 years, Start Smart; 5/6, Tee Ball; 7/8, Coach Pitch. Practice begins in March and games start on April 5. **Ages 9-18.** Registration: Cost is \$90 (discounts for siblings) for ages 9/10 and 11/12. 13 years and up is \$95. Age cutoff: Age of child on April 30, 2010. Birth certificate required. In person registration at Stewartsboro Elementary School on 2-6 and 2-13 from 9AM to 2PM or access www.smyrnabaseball.org for additional information.

Smyrna Girl's Softball League – Ages 4 – 20. Fee \$55. Registration is every Saturday in February from 9AM to 3PM, March 2 from 6:30PM – 8:30pm, April 3 and 10 from 9:00AM-12:00 PM, April 13 from 6:30PM-8:30PM at Volunteer Park. Birth certificate required if child did not play previous season. Child must be 4 by September 1, 2009 for Start Smart program. Fee for Start Smart program is \$35.
