

Meeting Minutes of the Town of Smyrna Stormwater Advisory Committee

September 2, 2004 at 5:00 PM

Steve Steele called the meeting to order at 5:03P.M. on September 2, 2004.

The members confirmed that they already had the minutes from the meeting of August 5, 2004. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes.

The committee then addressed the following issues:

- 1) WaterWorks Program & Tennessee Association of Broadcasters PSA opportunity.
 - Greg presented a brief overview of the program as was listed in the meeting agenda.
 - Paul presented the idea of subscribing for one quarter then having John Lanza, media, create segments for broadcasting on the new Smyrna channel 3.

- 2) Project WET – After the Storm opportunity
 - Greg presented a brief overview of the program as was listed in the meeting agenda.
 - Paul suggested having Laurina Lyle present the workshop in front of a camera and then have it broadcasted on Channel 3.
 - Greg replied saying that much of the workshop is actual hands-on work that could not be conveyed over a television.
 - Paul went on to say that perhaps the Catfish character or even a new character, perhaps a Duck, could still be broadcasted on channel 3.
 - The members seemed to be in unison about the need for such a program and that superintendent Gill, a Smyrna resident, would probably be in favor of it.
 - The members also suggested that Greg contact the other three MS4s in Rutherford County in an effort to fill the 25 maximum occupancy workshop, while distributing the cost amongst them as well.

3) Dry Detention Basin Policy

- The meeting had to end abruptly as Paul informed Greg that three of the members had to leave for a 5:30 PM meeting. Because it was already 5:35PM the meeting was quickly adjourned.

4) Buffer Zone Policy

- Same as #3.

The next meeting of the Town of Smyrna Storm Water Advisory Committee(SWAC) is to be announced, although there will probably be two between the writing of these minutes and the next Planning Commission meeting scheduled for October 7, 2004.
