

Meeting Minutes of the Town of Smyrna Stormwater Advisory Committee

March 3, 2005 at 5:00 PM

Greg Upham called the meeting to order at 5:05PM on March 3, 2005.

The committee addressed the following issues:

- 1) Sediment control measures (MS4 measure #4) is realizing some progress, but several 'problem' developers and home builders are still noncompliant.
- 2) The Town of Smyrna Council passed the fees program (7-0) as an addendum to the recently enacted Storm Water Management Ordinance on first reading, February 8th. The second reading will be during the March 8th Town Council meeting.
- 3) Municipal Pollution Prevention Plans/MPPP (MS4 measure #6) progress, includes very constructive meetings with Hal and Monica (Golf Course), Edd (Buildings and Grounds), and a postponed second meeting with Mike (Parks), while meetings with the Streets Department, WWTP, and WTP still need to be arranged and held.
- 4) Public Education and Outreach (MS4 measure #1) progress, includes a very productive meeting between the Assistant Superintendent of Rutherford County Schools (Curriculum), Mr. Don Odom and his K-5 assistant, Ms. Bogle, Ms. Laurina Lyle, Water Education for Teachers (WET)-After the Storm Program state manager, and representatives of Rutherford County, City of Murfreesboro, and Town of Smyrna storm water management programs to discuss the opportunity of offering WET – After the Storm Program training workshops for fifth grade teachers (cross-checking of their required curriculum and that of the WET-After the Storm Program must be performed before approval is made) and an informative webpage, consisting of a two-page introductory statement, the Storm Water Management Ordinance, the Water Quality Buffer Zone and Dry Detention Basin policies, the '03-'04, Year-1 Annual Report to TDEC, the most recent 12 SWAC meeting minutes, and a glossary of SWM terms and acronyms, while the Town of Smyrna webpage had the Storm Water Management Coordinator's name, title, and phone number added to its directories.
- 5) Public Participation and Involvement (MS4 measure #2) progress, includes an open invitation to the general public, through the Engineering-Stormwater webpage introductory statement, to join the soon to be started Stewart Creek Watershed Assoc.
- 6) Illicit Discharge Elimination (MS4 measure #3) progress, includes GIS mapping of all restaurants, school cafeterias, nursing homes, and churches that may have grease traps in an effort to track those that might be failing.
