Steve called the meeting to order at 5:05PM on April 6, 2006.

The committee addressed the following issues:

1. Minutes to last meeting were distributed and approved
2. Brief round the table self-introductions of old and new members and guest was completed
3. A review of the responsibilities of the SWAC was completed
 - a. Learns of what the Storm Water Management (SWM) Program, a.k.a. MS4 Permit is
 - b. Learns of program progress
 - c. Learns of education and outreach efforts, with the opportunity to participate
 - d. Provides peer-review to new policies and ordinances in preparation for Planning Commission review
 - e. Provides suggestions to assist in the improvement of the SWM Program
 - f. Has the opportunity of becoming a participant in SWM Program activities
4. Discuss the following achievements the Town of Smyrna SWM program has made since the last meeting of the SWAC in January 2006.
 - a. Dodd Galbreath spoke to combined groups about 'Natural Solutions to SWM Issues and Low Impact Development'. Mr. Galbreath has since been filmed and can be viewed on Channel 3 starting as soon as next week.
 - b. Invited Dr. Brown to speak to combined groups about 'Pervious Concrete'. Dr. Brown's presentation should be viewable on Channel 3 in a few weeks.
 - c. Plans are being made for presentations at July and October combined meetings.
 - d. Gained rights to use the artwork from a storm drain decal inherited from the Stones River Watershed Association then assisted our sign-maker, Joe Sartino in designing a bilingual sign. Mike Moss, Parks Director established sign locations along greenway. Joe installed 9 of the 16 signs, while our legal counsel, Michele Elliott, determined that federal, state, and local laws can be enforced and established ties with USACE. Newspaper and website articles were submitted.
 - e. Two cleanup events scheduled for Earth Day, April 22, 2006 are coordinated to be part of Tennessee's Great American Cleanup (GAC) effort. Tennessee is trying to become the first state ever to have events in all of its counties.
 - f. Planning WaterFest-2 in conjunction with grand opening of Gregory Mills Park.
 - g. Completed 55 construction site inspections with written responses.
 - h. Initiated auto repair/body shop inspections (35) to complement grease receptacle (55) and detention basin inspections (87).
 - i. The '06-'07 budget was submitted to include the addition of one staff (1>2).
 - j. Preparing for first program audit by TDEC in April.
