

**MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA  
STORM WATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

November 17, 2008

The November meeting of the Town of Smyrna Storm Water Advisory Committee was held on Monday, November 17, 2008. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Rob White at 7:00 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee.

**1st Item: Approval of Minutes of the October 20, 2008 Meeting**

The Committee considered a motion by Paul Johns to approve the minutes of the October 20, 2008 meeting as presented. The motion was seconded by Ray Lee. The motion was approved unanimously. A copy of the minutes as approved are attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "1".

**2nd Item: Old Business**

There was no old business to discuss at this meeting.

**3rd Item: New Business**

a. **Approval of Corrections**

The Committee considered a motion by Rhett Kimble to approve the Storm Water Fee Corrections as presented. The motion was seconded by Charles King. The motion was approved unanimously. A copy of the Storm Water Fee Corrections as approved are attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "2".

**b. Adjustment Application – Heath – 374 Chaney Road**

An adjustment application was received from Horace Heath for the property located at 374 Chaney Road. A copy of this application is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit “3”.

The following recommendations/comments were made by staff:

1. Removal of 180 sf of impervious surface identified as the RV.
2. The storm waters from the property discharges through a culvert underneath Chaney Road into the city limits of LaVergne, then re-enters the Town of Smyrna; therefore, ultimately discharges through the Town’s storm water system.
3. The southern driveway on the property is gravel which, according to our ordinance, is an impervious surface and should be calculated into the total impervious area.

At this time, Chairman Rob White recognized Mr. Horace Heath to speak regarding his request.

Following discussion, a motion was made by Rhett Kimble to approve the application, as recommended by staff, and reduce the impervious surface from 11,654 sf to 11,474 sf. The motion was duly seconded by Nicole Fabian and approved unanimously.

**c. Credit Applications – None this month.**

**4th Item: Reports of Officers, Committees, or Staff**

a. David King reported that Nissan has submitted a Credit Application which is under review and will be submitted to the Committee next month.

b. David King then reported to the Committee that to date, staff has received 119 calls/inquires about the Storm Water User Fee and 55 site-specific information packets were mailed out.

**5th Item: Adjournment**

There being no further business to come before the Committee, a motion was made by Paul Johns to adjourn the meeting and a second by Gunner Miller. Without objection, the meeting was adjourned at 7:28 PM.
