

Meeting Minutes of the Town of Smyrna Storm Water Advisory Committee

May 5, 2005 at 5:00 PM

Steve Steele called the meeting to order at 5:05PM on May 5, 2005

The committee addressed the following issues:

1. All but two of the contractors of the nine construction sites cited for a NOV have done more than adequate jobs of correcting their problems.
2. Subsequent inspections are being completed and appropriate correspondences are being mailed as needed.
3. The Golf Course and Parks Department Municipal Pollution Prevention Plans (MPPP) are being written.
4. Instructions have been created to assist the managers on how they are to complete their portions of the MPPPs.
5. Greg is in the process of lining up interviews with the managers of the Water & Sewer, Gas, and Streets Departments, Waste Water Treatment Plant, and Water Treatment plant, while a second meeting with Edd is still needed.
6. Nine individual three-ring binders have been labeled in preparation of being filled with official MPPPs.
7. Laurina Lyle, former manager of the Water Education for Teachers (WET) – After the Storm program, has resigned to join the University of the South staff. Inquires to APSU have resulted in affirmation by its leadership that a satisfactory replacement is already employed in a different capacity and will make the transition to head up this program in the near future.
8. In partnership with the Stones River Watershed Association (SRWA), Division of Water Pollution Control (TDEC), Tennessee Scenic Rivers Association (TSRA), MTSU, Rutherford Recycling Program, and the County of Rutherford, the 1st Annual Stewart Creek WaterFest is scheduled for May 21st from 1-5PM at Volunteer Park. An overview of the SRWA efforts and those of the burgeoning Stewart Creek Watershed Association (SCWA) will be presented and in-stream demonstrations of biological surveying/assessment and safe canoeing will be given. All of you are invited to attend and participate if you would like.

The next meeting of the Town of Smyrna SWAC is scheduled for June 2, 2005 at 5:00PM.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:25PM.
