



Providence Community Corrections, Inc.

As a condition of your bond, you have been ordered by the Judge to participate in SCRAM or Electronic Monitoring (EM) and must have this completed by the time specified by the Judge.

If the Judge orders that you be placed on SCRAM, it is an alcohol monitoring bracelet that is placed on your ankle. The cost is \$12 per day. Before you sign up, you must have a payment of one week which is \$84.00 plus the installation fee of \$25.00 for a total of \$109.00 before it will be placed on your ankle. You must wear low cut shoes and pants that are not tight around the ankle. You will need to report to PCC twice per week for download. The times are Mondays 8:30 – 11:30 am or 1:00- 5:00 pm and Thursday 8:30 – 11:30 am or 1:00 – 5:00 pm. You will need to bring a cashier's check or money order for \$84.00 once per week until your charge has been settled. Failure to do so will result in the Judge being advised of your non-compliance. **While on SCRAM you are to refrain from alcohol use of any kind.** Again, failure to do so will result in the Judge being advised of your non-compliance at which time the Judge may choose to revoke your bond and will be in jail until your court date.

If the Judge orders you be placed on Electronic Monitoring (EM), it is an electronic monitoring bracelet (house arrest) that is placed on your ankle. The Judge will issue instructions as to when you are able to leave the house. The cost is \$10.00 per day and you must have a home phone line (NO CALLER ID, NO CALL WAITING, ETC.) Before you can sign up, you must have a payment of one week in advance which is \$70.00 plus \$25.00 for installation for a total of \$95 before it will be placed on your ankle. You will need to pay \$70.00 a week and be prepared to pay this amount once per week until your case is settled. Failure to pay and follow the conditions of house arrest will result in the Judge being advised of your non-compliance

You must contact Kristi Dunnam or Jessica Johnson at 615-355-9577 to set up an appointment. It is suggested that you contact PCC to schedule an appointment on the first business day upon bonding out. This appointment will take up to 45 minutes to an hour. You must wear low cut shoes and pants that are not tight around the ankle.

I understand what the court has ordered and will comply with the Judge's instructions. I understand that failure to do so may result in the Judge revoking my bond.
